

This makes a Mandalla garden of approximately 6m².

- 1) Place a stake in the centre
- 2) Identify where the entrance path will be
- 3) Take a string 5.4m long. Knot one end around the central stake
- 4) Knot the string around another stake 1.8m away. (This should be placed 0.5m from the entrance path - i)
- 5) Create another knot 1.8m from the previous stake. Place a third stake inside this then tie the end to the central stake.
There is now a triangle with a stake at each point - ii.
- 6) Slip the knot off the third stake then move it to the other side of stake 2. Position a 4th stake at this position - iii
Continue in this way to create a hexagon around the central stake.
- 7) A small circle is then described around each stake, including the central one - iv
- 8) Small beds can be built up within the shape. Use layers of sheet mulch (cardboard), composted manure
